2019 NEW RULES

- Challenger Fee for all shows now \$200
- Standing Rule 13 remove Unit Payout requirements for weekend show classes \$5,000 or more in added money and replace with the standard weekend show mandatory payout (in part)

“Weekend shows with classes with \$5,000 and more in added money must have one go-round and finals with all money to be paid out in the finals. The top 25% of entries will advance to finals with a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12. The top 50% in the finals will receive a check based on the NCHA mandatory payout system, with all finalists to receive a base pay of two times their entry fee.”
- 3A judges may officiate at any NCHA approved or sponsored event up to \$2,000 added by themselves. When added money is over \$1,000 the judge must be approved by the Director of Judges
- Show with added purses of more than \$2,000 must use two (2) judges from the appropriate NCHA Approved Judge classification.
- Standing Rule 5 all classes approved/unapproved held within NCHA approved show must remit the 8% fee
- Please refer to attached changes to Standing Rule 14 regarding # of entries versus lowering of added and entry fees.
- Standing Rule 8 - \$15,000 Amateur, \$35,000 Non Pro and \$2,000 Limit Rider with one go round maximum entry fee changed from \$90 to \$100.
- LAE Major limited age events maximum # horses worked per day 120
- LAE Major limited age events only the accumulative score will be posted in the arena. No individual scores will be available anywhere, except a copy of the official Judge's Cards, which will be posted on the following day or at the completion of the go round.
