Rules:

- 1. To qualify for saddle ride-off contestant must show at 50% + 1 shows (i.e. 15 show days = 8 show days to qualify).
- 2. Contestant must be current member of OCHA
- 3. Association will drop down in each class to have 3 qualified contestants in each class.
- 4. Year-end standings are based on money earned.
- 5. Contestant must be present to win and compete in ride-off to win.
- 6. The Oregon CHA Executive Committee reserves the right should it be deemed necessary, to make any changes or alterations to the above rules.
